EVERETT, WA.- The physician from King County who has a suspected case of Swine Flu, is a pediatrician who contracts with The Everett Clinic. She became ill on Monday night, after seeing patients that day in our Pediatric Department. The Clinic is currently contacting the parents of the patients she saw on Monday. Those families, as well as staff who worked with our doctor, will be evaluated and treated as necessary. The health of those who may have been exposed is our primary concern. Every measure is being taken to ensure they receive the treatment and information that may be needed.

The doctor has not recently traveled to Mexico, nor is she aware of any people with whom she has been in contact who have.

The Everett Clinic has been conducting daily meetings to prepare for the arrival of Swine Flu in Washington State. Several safety measures have already been activated. A team of doctors and administrative leaders worked through the night to implement plans to safely treat patients who may have been exposed to the virus.

Our Medical Director of Walk-In Clinic's, Dr Yuan-Po Tu, will be available to update reporters at 10:30 today, at 3901 Hoyt Ave, Everett, 98201.
